Recently, in fact, there have been several excellent tours that would have gone as scheduled except for the fact that too many people waited too long to sign up for the tour. In fact, we had one tour last year that was cancelled due to lack of interest. This very same tour was oversold within a week. Fortunately on this tour, we were able to rebook the motorcoach and attractions, saving it from cancellation. This is not the norm in most cases.

Additionally, there were several “sold out” tours that we could have added an additional coach, if people had called and booked before the deadline.

Don’t let a small deposit keep you from signing up for a tour, as again, it is ***Totally Refundable if Cancelled by SignaTours. In short . . . Don’t Wait To Sign Up!***

We make every effort possible to ensure each scheduled tour is a “go.” We therefore ask that if you are interested in a particular tour, don’t wait until it’s too late.
