Recently, several tragic motorcoach events have taken place, leaving many travelers alarmed about their personal safety. You have every reason to be concerned about your welfare and that of your family and friends. You can help avoid these type accidents and serious injury by knowing your tour operator and the motorcoach carriers they provide. Before you get on that church mini-bus or sign up for that cheap casino trip and before you take that bargain tour with a motorcoach company or tour operator you don't know, ask yourself this one simple question . . . Is it worth it?

Do you know if your driver has experience operating motorcoaches? Do you know if your driver is drug free? Do you know how many hours your driver has been on duty? Do you know the safety ratings of your driver and motorcoach? When were the brakes last inspected? What about the tires? In addition to safety, do you know if your money is safe when traveling on a tour planned without the use of a licensed, bonded and insured agency? What happens to your money if the theatre or restaurant goes out of business? These are relevant questions you should know when signing up for tours, especially if groups try to save money by doing it on their own.

SignaTours only uses motorcoach carriers who meet very strict guidelines. In fact, Groome Transportation, our primary motorcoach provider, values safety as its biggest concern. Drivers are monitored on every trip taken and strict policies are kept in force to meet and exceed Federal and State laws. These policies allow drivers the rest needed between tours to avoid the lack of concentration and driver fatigue. Driver records are continuously monitored thru a state program and all drivers are subject to pre-employment, reasonable suspicion and random drug and alcohol testing. Drivers must maintain a safe driving record off the job and attend biannual training meetings which address relevant issues pertaining to motorcoach safety. The use of “DriveCam's,” a behavioral based video recording system, are also in use aboard the motorcoaches. Its purpose is to record any unusual events associated with unnecessary G-Forces. Lastly, its entire fleet is independently inspected on a monthly basis by an ASE Certified Master Technician.

SignaTours is fully licensed, bonded and insured and meets all guidelines to operate a tour planning operation as required by local, state and federal laws. Professional memberships include the National Tour Association, American Bus Association, Virginia Motorcoach Association, Int'l Assoc. of Travel Agents, Vacation.com, Better Business Bureau, Chamber of Commerce and several other travel affiliations.
