Visiting the *White House* during the *Holiday Season* has become an annual tradition in our *Nation's Capital*. Your tour includes the Blue, Green and Red Rooms, East Room, Library, State Dining Room and the White House Christmas Tree with a theme chosen by the First Lady. Visit the *White House Visitor Center* where you can purchase special gifts and the 2012 White House Ornament.

Depending on our allotted tour times at the White House, a visit will be made to *Mount Vernon*. Beautifully decorated for the holidays, the Mansion looks much like it would have during George Washington's life. In the orientation center, visitors get an unprecedented look at furnishings, china, silver, clothing, jewelry, Revolutionary War artifacts, rare books, manuscripts and other personal effects of the Washington family. The centerpiece of a visit to this 500-acre estate is a tour through 14 rooms of the mansion, whose oldest parts date from the 1740's. Mount Vernon encompasses many memories and the fine tastes of both George and Martha throughout the entire estate. Visit *The Shops at Mount Vernon* during your stay. Lunch is included at a popular Washington restaurant.



White House Tour Dates *"Are Not Finalized"* until Approval by the White House Staff in "Early December." *White House Policy requires names and security information to accompany all requests for White House Tours. Therefore, if you wish to sign up, you "Must" be available to travel on "All" of the above listed dates. We have narrowed the dates to three consecutive days this year.* Send check or pay by phone and required security forms will then be sent to your home to be filled out and returned immediately to our office. *Please "Do Not Call" asking for tour dates as you will be notified of the date and time within 48 hours of our confirmation from the White House. Dates will not be given out over the phone.*

Once our office receives your information, \$50.00 is non-refundable should you cancel. Government issued photo identification is required by the White House. Due to popularity of this tour, reservations should be made and paid for and security information received in our office no later than **July 31, 2012**. Last year's tours sold out by July. Do not procrastinate in calling our office. It may just be too late! *"Payment in Full" is due with sign up!*
