**Monday - April 11<sup>th</sup>**: (Continental Breakfast/Dinner)

**Richmond to Savannah, Georgia**

Early morning departures from Richmond begin a spectacular five-day excursion to the “Historic South.” Sit back and relax as you journey south into a whole new world of “Springtime Beauty.” A continental breakfast en route is included this morning. Midday stop for lunch, cost is on your own. Additional stops will be made throughout the day and tour for the necessary rest and comfort breaks. Arrive in historic Savannah late this afternoon and check into the *Springhill Suites Savannah Historic District*, your home for the next two nights. After a busy day of travel, enjoy a delicious dinner this evening at . . . *Paula Deen’s “Lady and Sons Restaurant.”* Wonderful entrees, combined with casual dining and warm hospitable service, make your evening out on the town most memorable!

**Tuesday - April 12<sup>th</sup>**: (Deluxe Continental Breakfast/Dinner)

**Savannah**

Begin your day with a *Deluxe Continental Breakfast* at the hotel before departing for historic *St. Simons Island*. The island has been a popular vacation destination for hundreds of years. Your narrated tour covers 400 years of island history and folklore. Drive-bys include the *Lighthouse*, one of three working lighthouses in Georgia; *Bloody Marsh*, site of the famous 1742 battle where the fate of the Southern Colonies was decided; *Fort Frederica*, the colonial town and fort settled by General James Edward Oglethorpe; *Retreat Plantation*, where relics from the slavery era still exist and historic *Christ Church*. Midday lunch in the Village is on your own. Travel a short distance to *Jekyll Island*, located just off the Georgia coast. A six-mile causeway separates Jekyll from the mainland and the city of Brunswick. Once there, visit the museum where you board a tram for a tour of the National Historic Landmark district. Your 90 minute tour includes entry into two of the cottages filled with rich tales and elegant furnishings. Free time in the Museum and gift shop. Dinner is included this evening on your return trip to Savannah.

**Wednesday - April 13<sup>th</sup>**: (Deluxe Continental Breakfast/Dinner)

**Savannah to Charleston**

Another *Deluxe Continental Breakfast* begins your day and is followed by a meeting with your professional local tour guide for a comprehensive *Savannah City Tour*. The historic city of Savannah greets her guests with a warm and unhurried atmosphere. Unique park squares, cobblestone and brick streets; mansions and row houses are shaded by Oak trees (draped in Spanish Moss) and stately Magnolia trees. Lunch is followed by free time on *River Street*; perfect opportunity to shop or browse the quaint stores that line the historic river area. Then it is time to travel to *Beaufort, SC* where you board a carriage for a *horse-and-buggy tour* of Old Point and parts of the downtown historic district. Hear the fascinating history of the city as well as stories about the grand houses and their owner as well as gossipy accounts of celebrity visitors and movie stars. Tour complete, travel to *Parris Island* for a riding tour of the “*basically trained Marines.*” 19,000 recruits are trained each year at this facility. Tour includes a visit to the *Marine Corp Museum*. Then it is time to sit down and enjoy one of the best seafood restaurants in the area. This waterfront location is the perfect spot to reflect on all of the beautiful sites visited today as you enjoy a delicious dinner. Meal complete, travel into Charleston, SC for a two night stay at the Springhill Suites Hotel.

**Thursday - April 14th:** (Deluxe Continental Breakfast/Picnic Box Lunch/Dinner)

**Charleston**

A **Deluxe Continental Breakfast** starts the day and is followed by a short drive to the **Charleston Tea Plantation**, located on Ladmalaw Island. The plantation is home to American Classic Tea, the **ONLY** tea grown in America. After an informative factory tour, take an enjoyable **Trolley Ride** through the tea fields and afterwards enjoy an iced drink and shopping in the gift shop. Board your motorcoach and travel to **Magnolia Plantation**. A delicious **box lunch** will be provided prior to a tour of the house and gardens. Founded in 1696, Magnolia has an extensive collection of Early American museum-quality antique furniture spanning ten generations. Your visit also includes a **45 minute boat ride** that explores the Plantation's 125 acres of rice fields, while guides describe plantation rice and river culture. This tour offers excellent wildlife viewing, including up-close looks at alligators. Touring complete, travel into Charleston for a visit to the **Calhoun Mansion**. This striking *italianate* designed mansion has 35 rooms, a grand ballroom, Japanese water gardens, 35 fireplaces and many more wonderful surprises. It has been critically acclaimed as one of "America's Castles." **Dinner** this evening is at a delightful restaurant located on the Ashley River. This restaurant has everything: superior service, fantastic food and incredible scenery

**Friday - April 15th:** (Deluxe Continental Breakfast/Lunch)

**Charleston to Richmond**

Your last day of travel begins with one last **Deluxe Continental Breakfast** at the hotel, prior to check-out and departure for a tour that is out of the ordinary. You'll be using a different type coach whose power is derived from "real horse power!" The "clip-clop" pace of a **Horse Drawn Carriage** is the best way to discover Charleston's past and present, up close and personal. At the conclusion of the tour, there is free time to enjoy the **Market** prior to lunch at one of the city's popular restaurants.
